This term we are:

- working on our name recognition and fine motor skills with – puzzles, peg games, art and mark making activities
- learning about caring for people, pets and the environment
- developing our independence with toilet use, washing hands, helping teachers, finding our coats, shoes etc.

- nature walks to include sorting, collecting and counting
